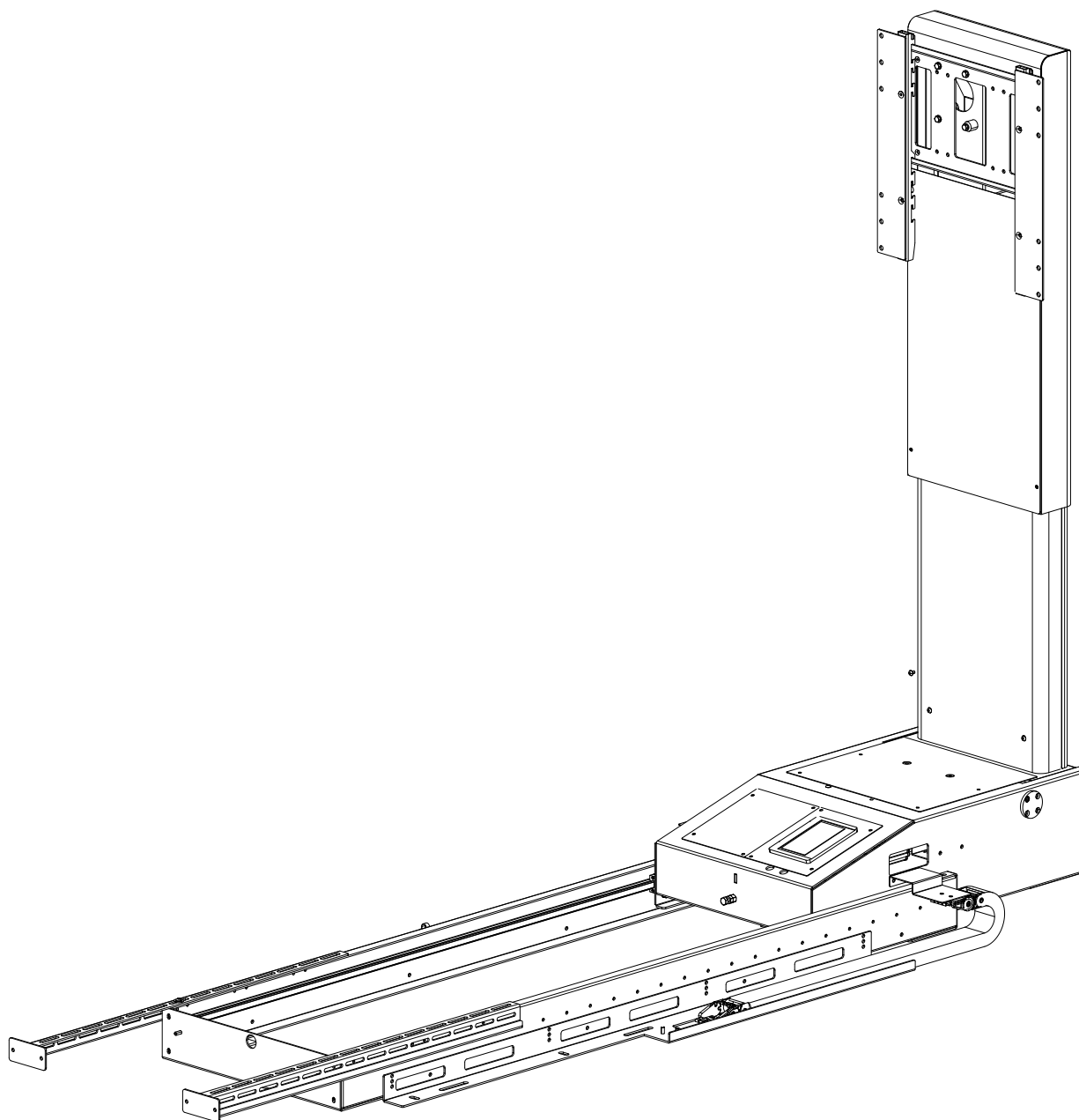

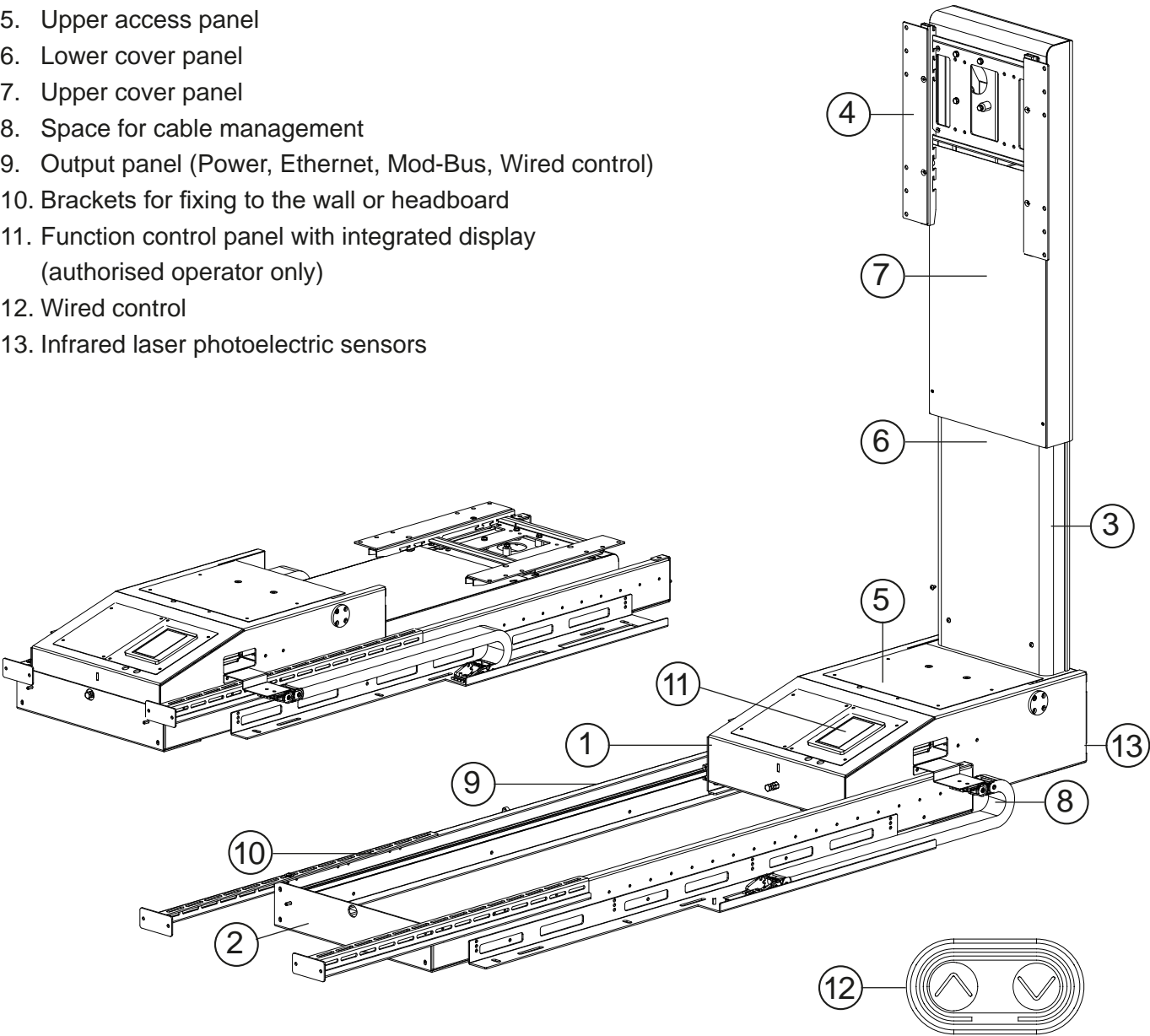
Product description

The BTV lift is designed and built to move a retractable TV. The product in the rest state is placed under the bed; pressing and holding the wired control button (supplied), the product switches the TV to the in-use state. The transition between the two states of rest/use takes place by means of three movements driven by three electric motors:

- **Horizontal translation (the TV comes out from under the bed);**
- **Rotation (the TV is brought to a vertical position);**
- **Raising (the TV is raised to the height preset during installation).**

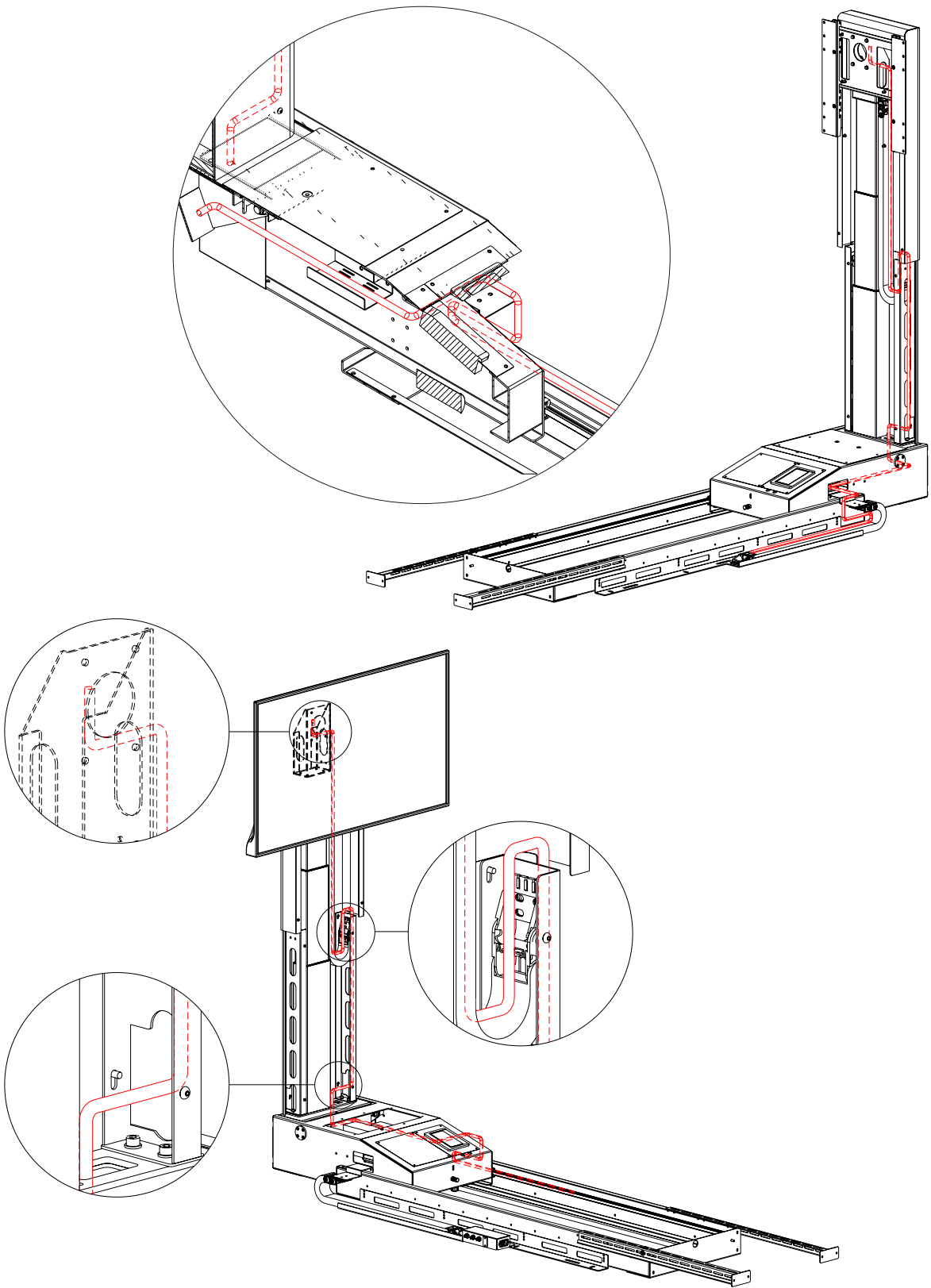

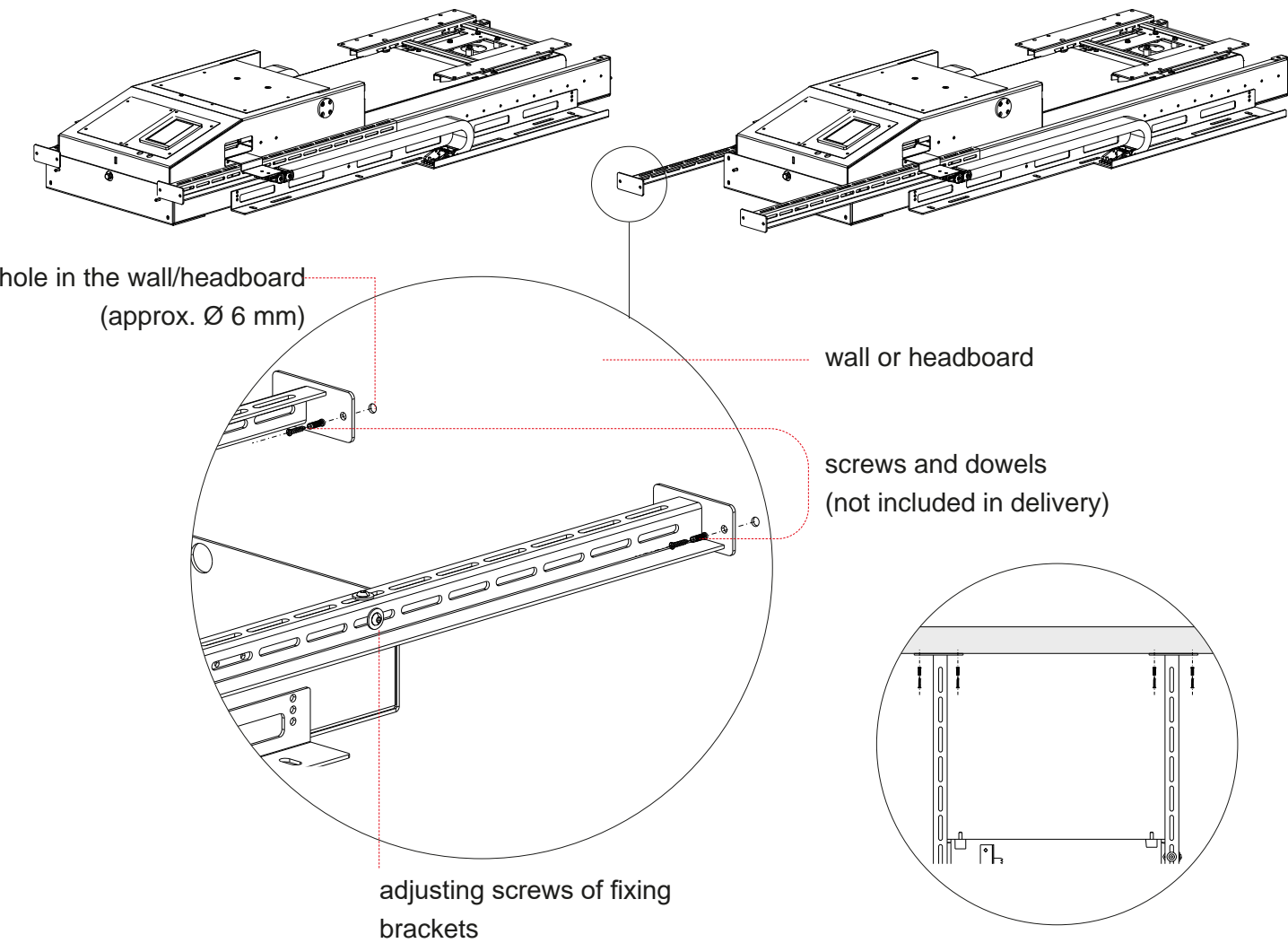
Wiring

Route the power and video source cables through the base of the device and into the side compartment, as illustrated, up to the top where the TV screen is to be installed. Replace all previously removed cover panels after positioning the cables.

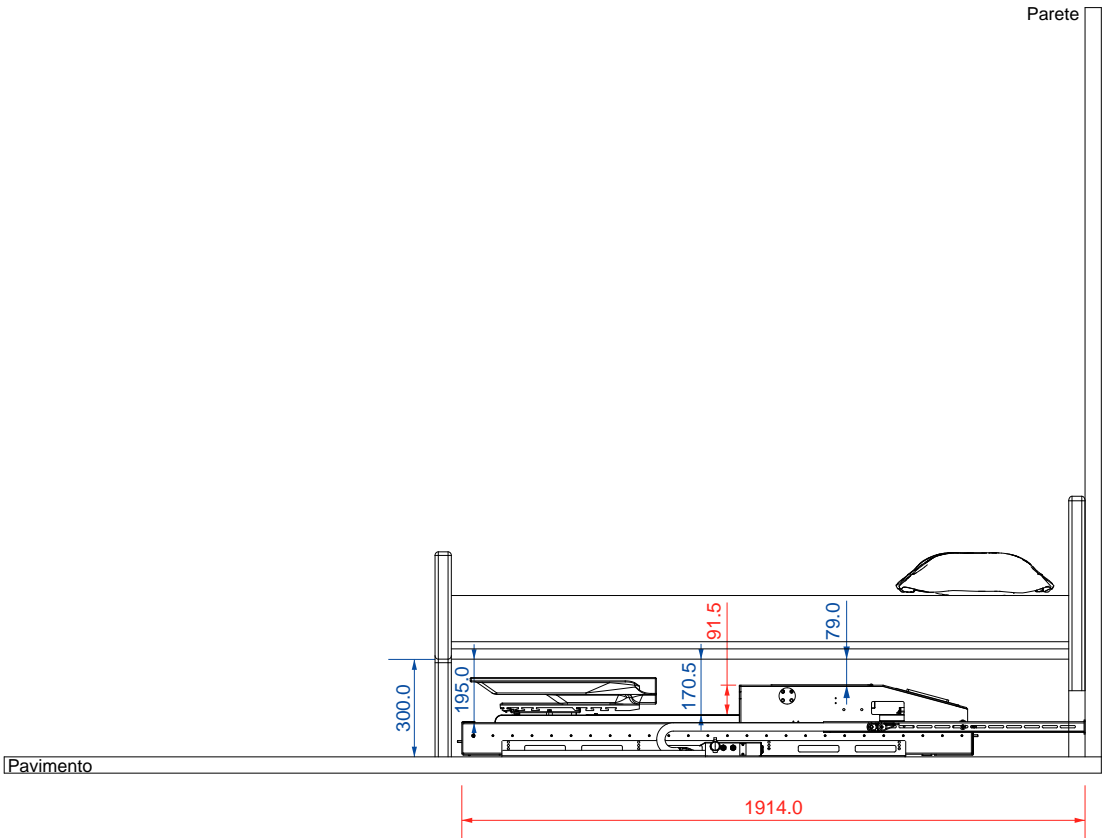
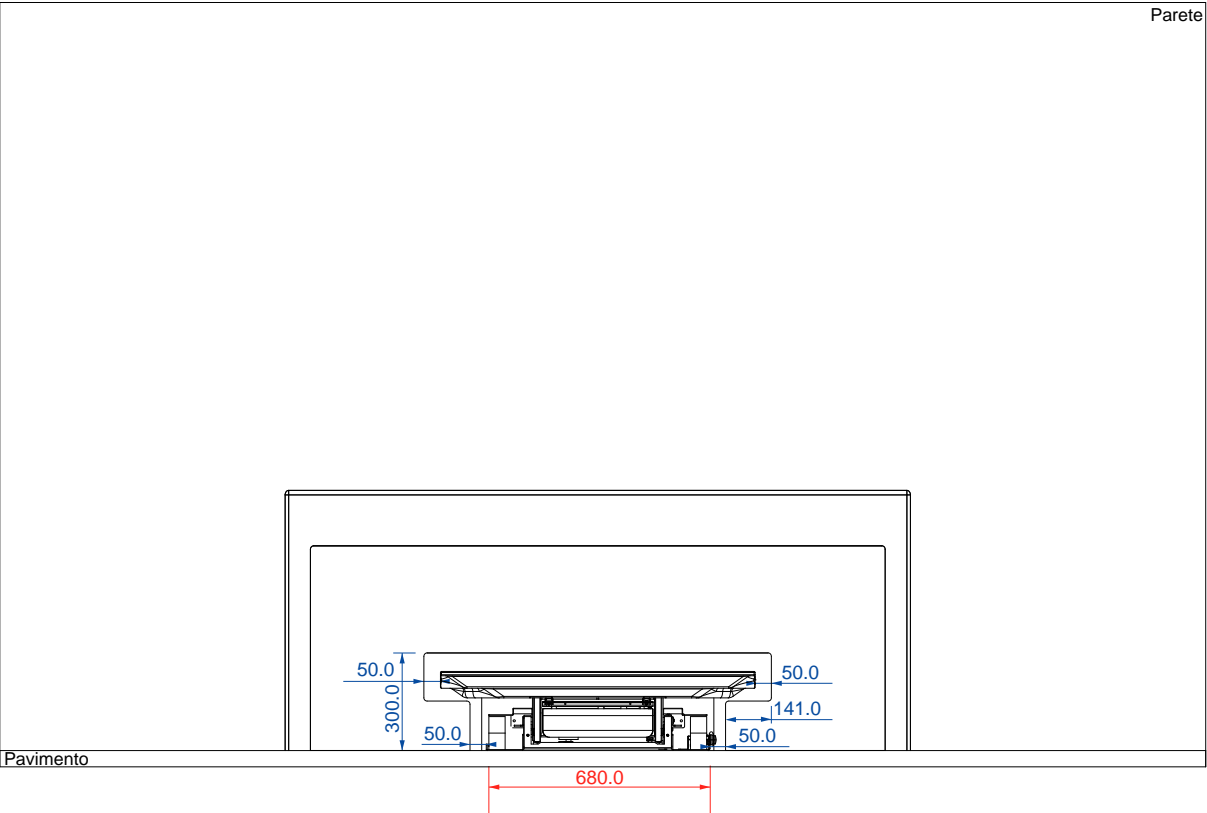


Positioning and fixing

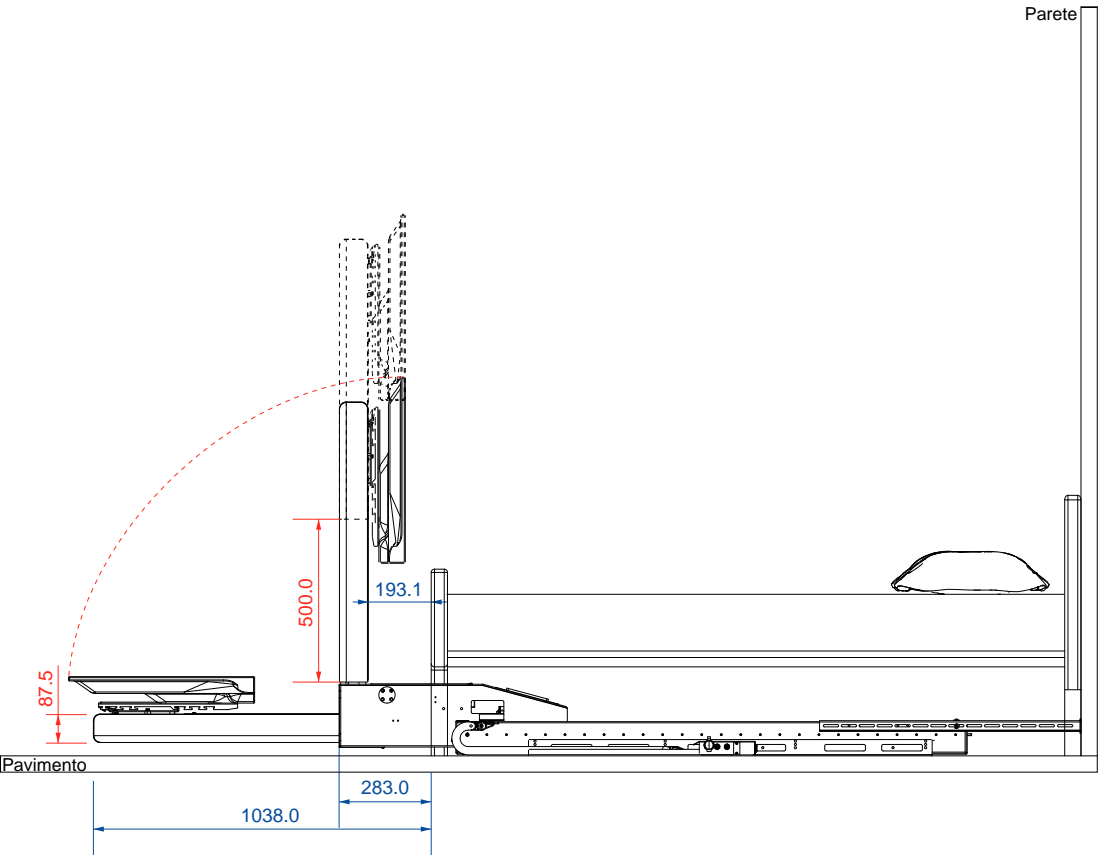
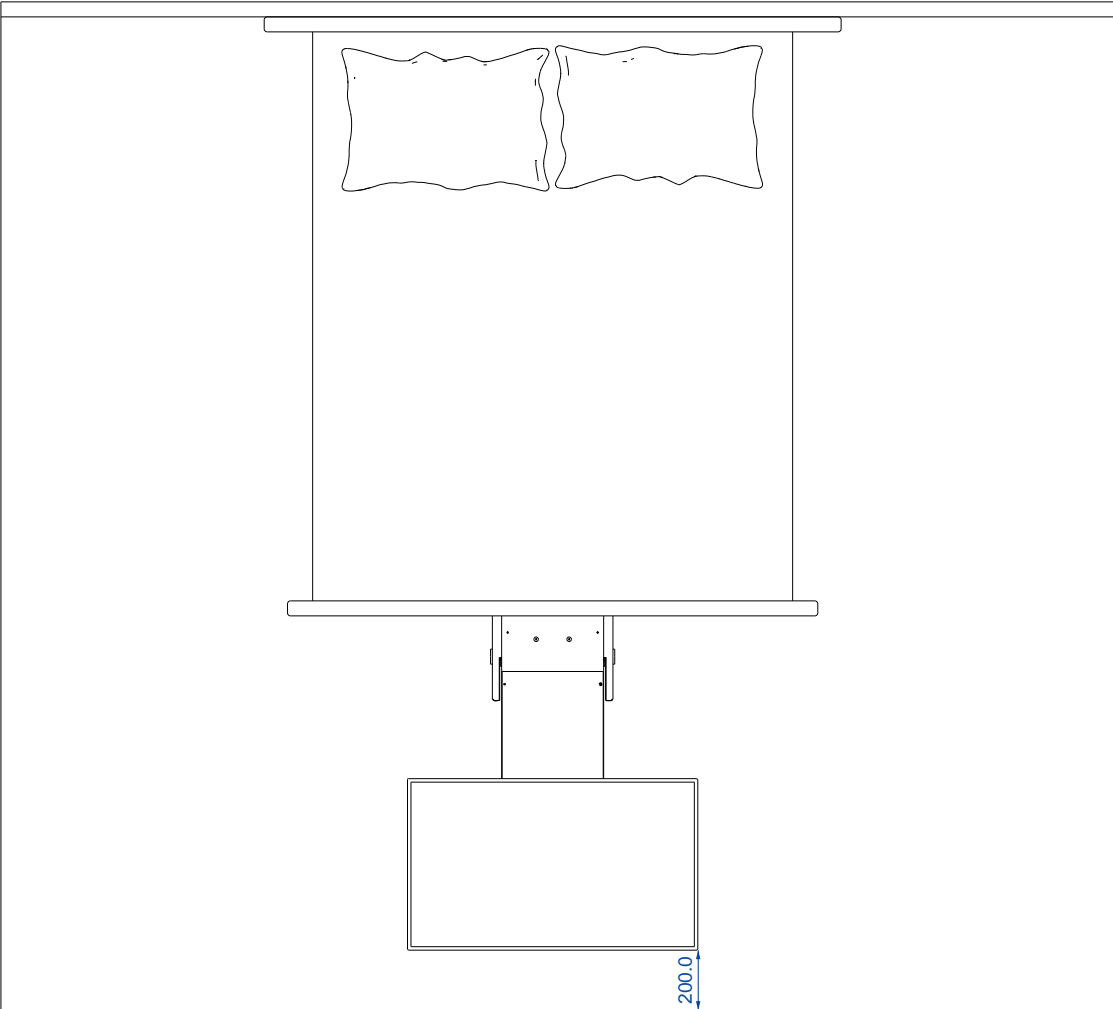
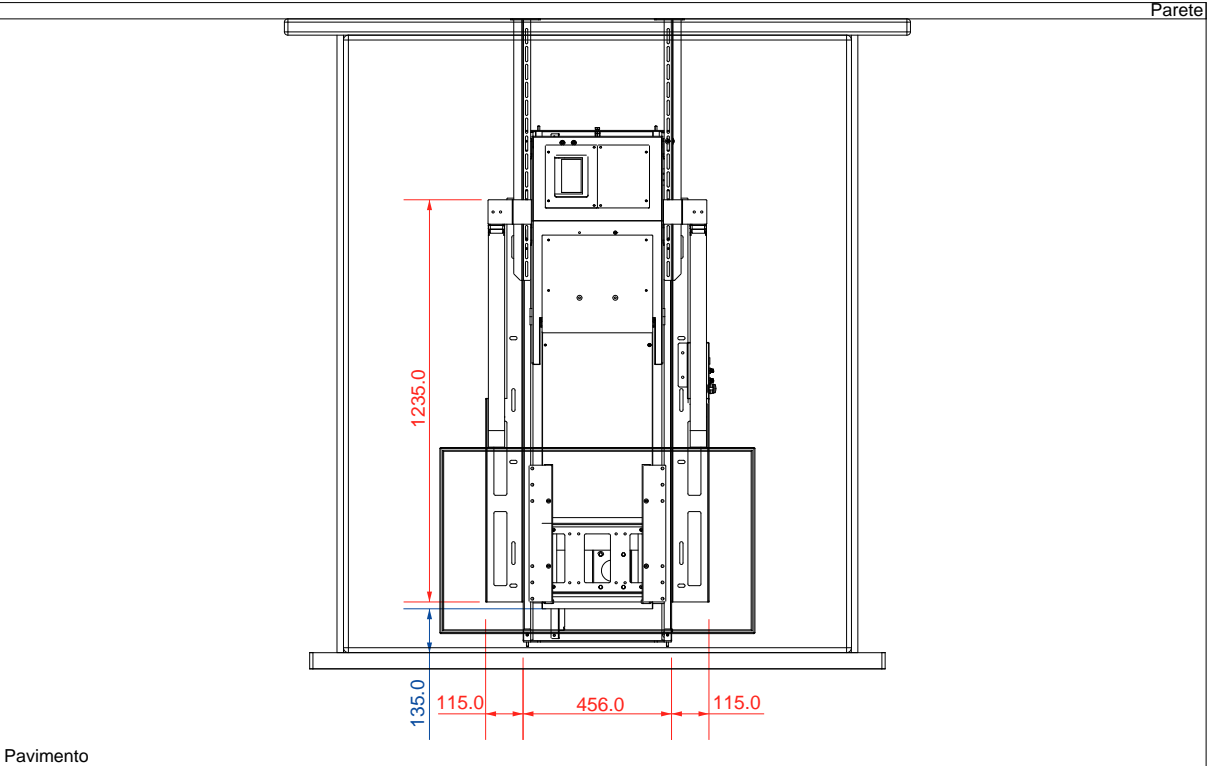


The bed frame inside which the product is to be installed must be closed at the sides and have the characteristics shown below in the drawings.

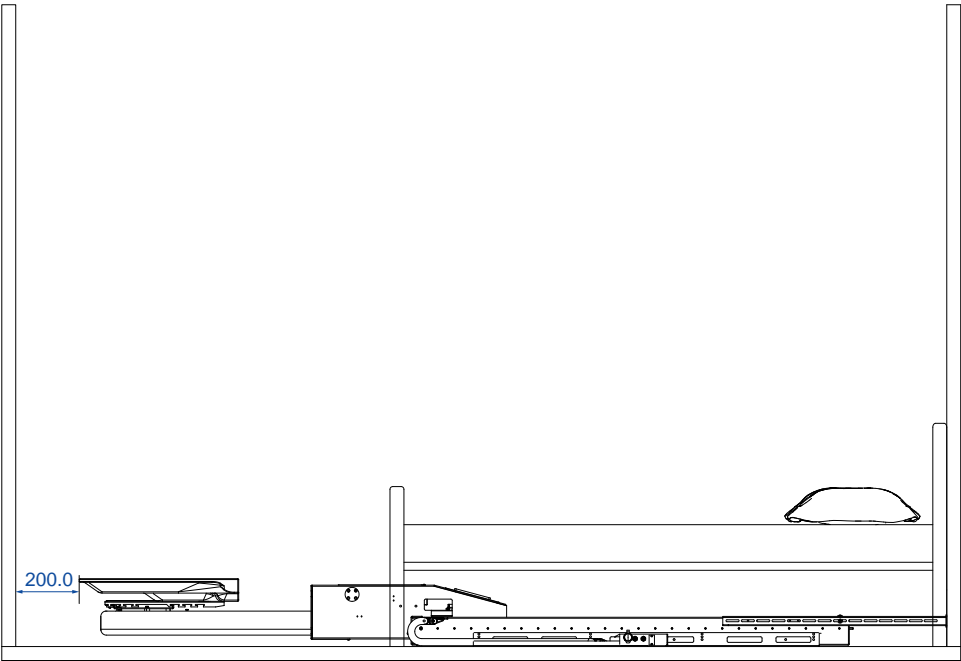
First, return the mechanism to the closed position. After checking that the reference dimensions (mm) of the area under the bed comply with the parameters given on the following pages, adjust the device fixing brackets and fix them to the rear wall as illustrated, using screws and dowels (for wood, wall or plasterboard walls) not supplied.



For correct operation of the device, observe the installation dimensions (mm) shown in the figures above.



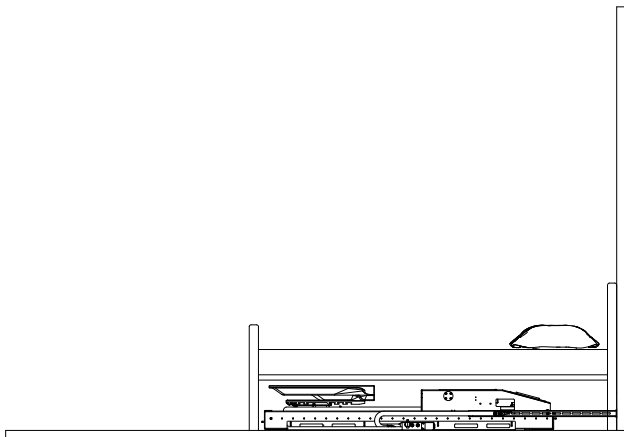

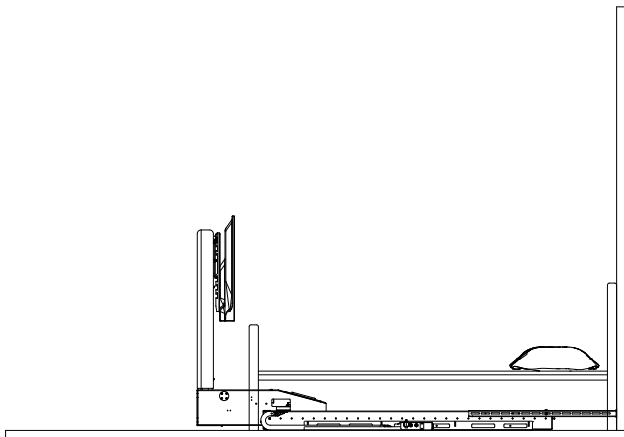
Observe a minimum distance of 200 mm (from walls or furniture) with the device in the translated position and TV installed.

Motion control mechanism

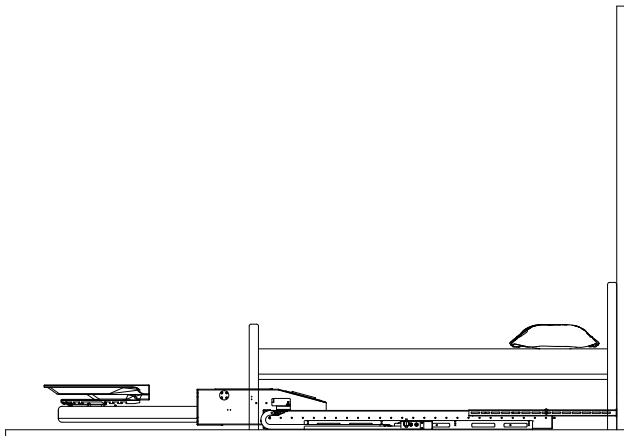
2D/3D view



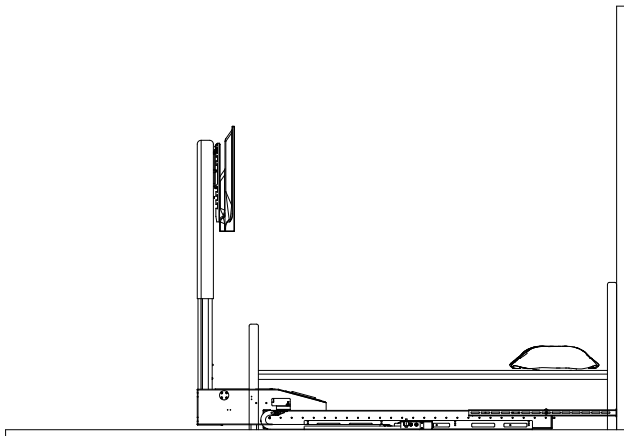
Lift in closed position with fixing brackets extended



Lift in 90° rotated position

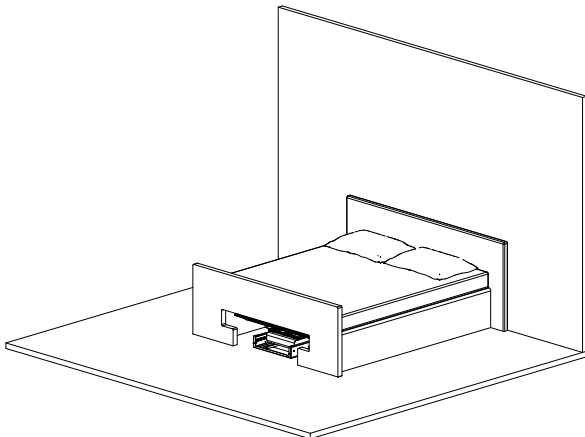


Lift in translated position

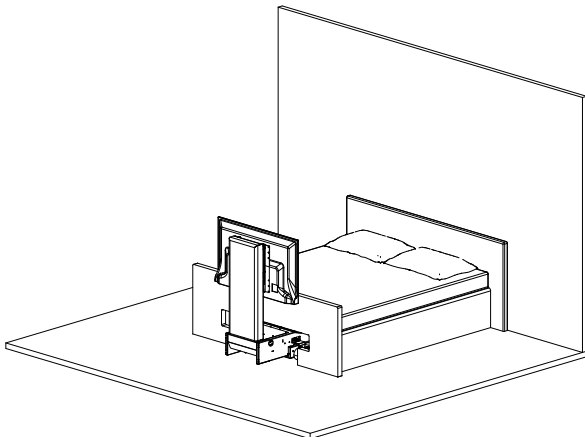


Lift in raised position

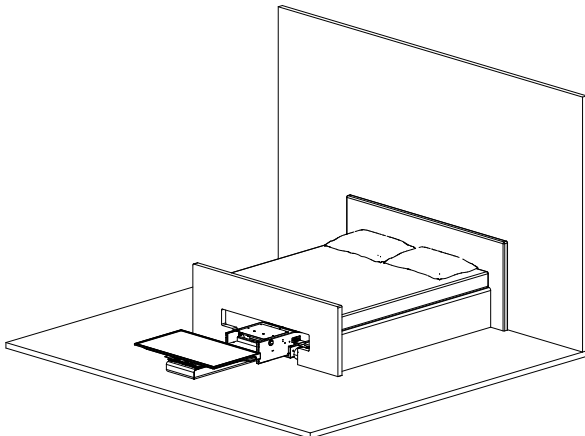
Check the distance of the mechanism through the movement cycle to ensure that it reaches the raised position without hitting any obstacles and that it has adequate clearance to the floor.



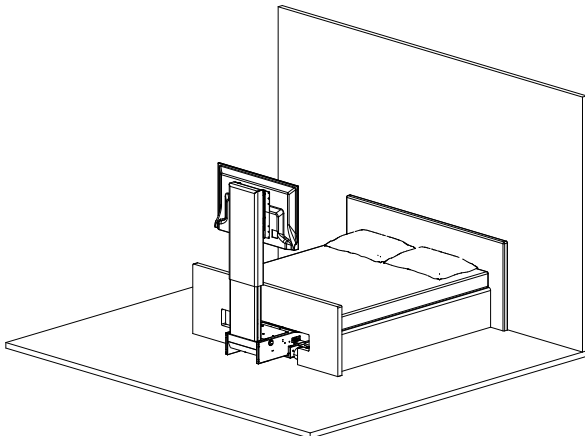
Lift in closed position with fixing brackets extended



Lift in 90° rotated position

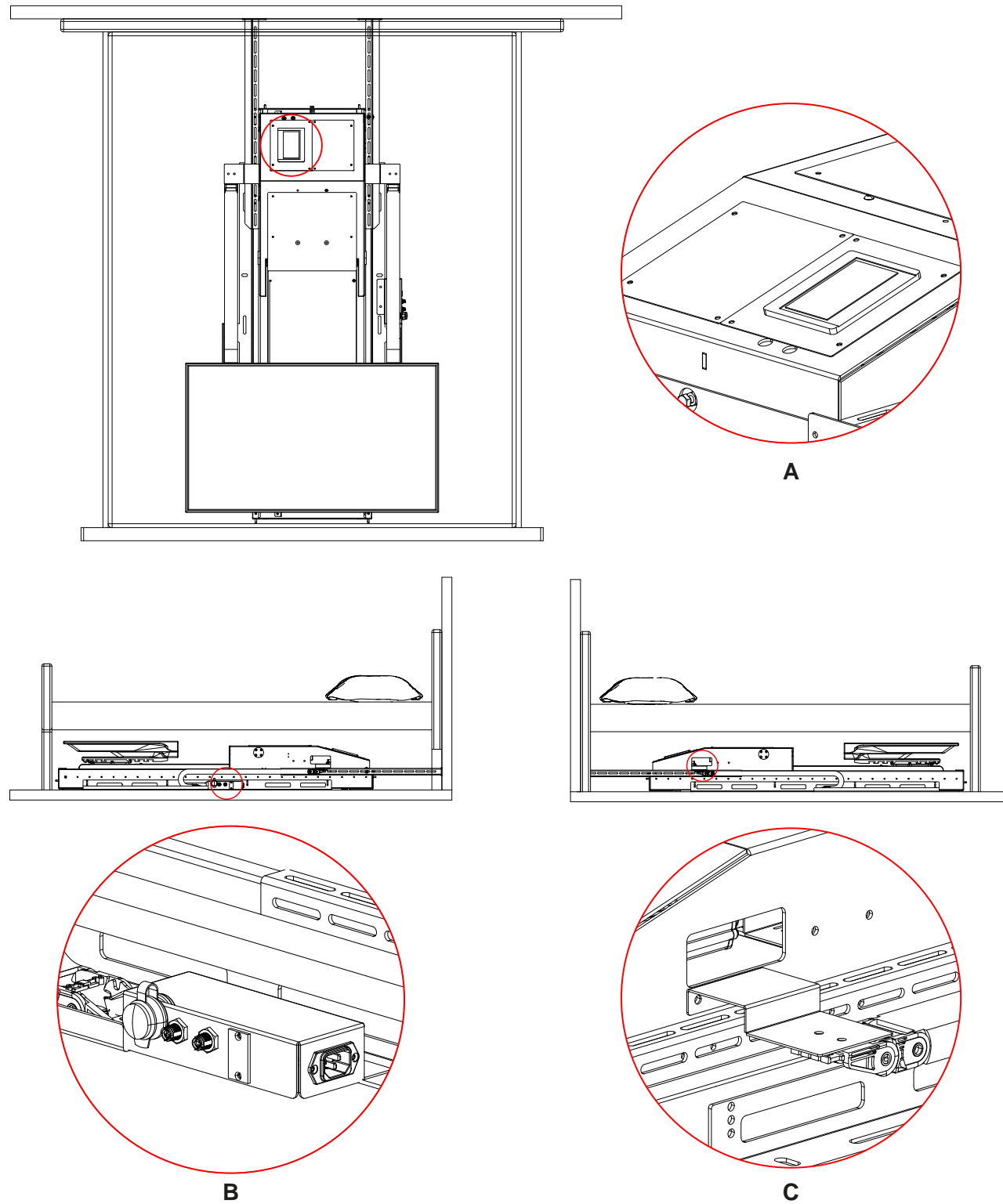


Lift in translated position

Ensure that there is sufficient space for the screen and uprights when the mechanism performs the hinge movement.

Detail B shows the housing detail for the power cable and other cable types for interfacing with compatible external devices.

Detail C shows the part where the cables for the TV monitors will be inserted.
