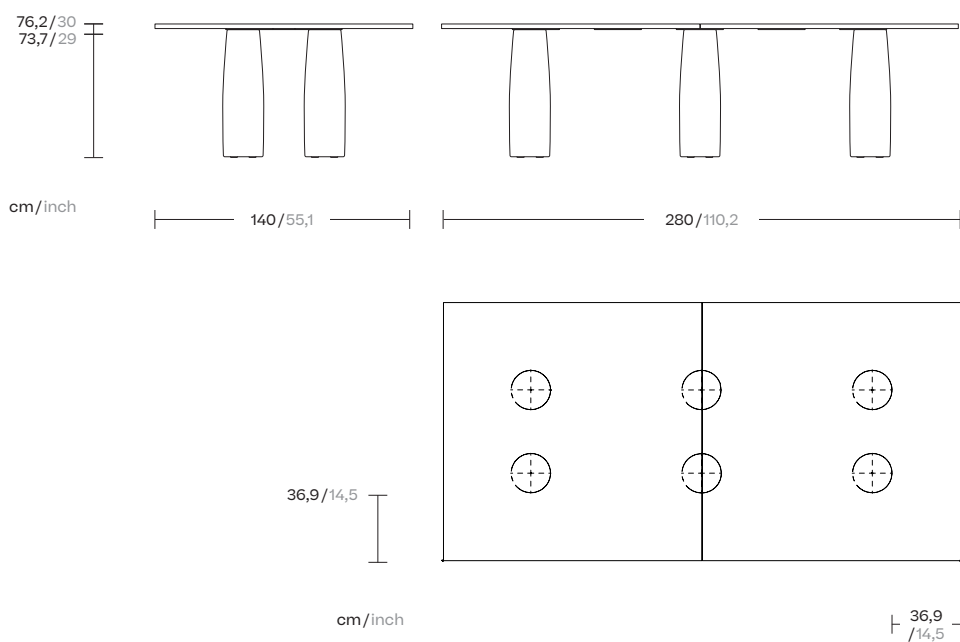

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In this project, Mario Bellini took his inspiration from a basic elemental structure in architecture. His design emulated the colonnade of classical architecture, in which a sequence of columns supports a portico, in this case a table top. The base is a visually closed volume, despite being materially open.

When seen from a different viewpoint, perception changes completely, as the columns no longer overlap and the space appears empty.



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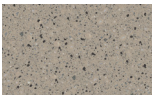

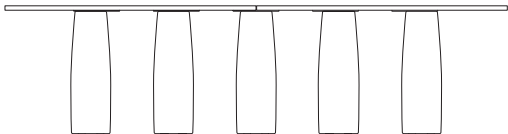
Maintenance

We suggest to treat our Minera stone as a product made of natural stone or marble. We suggest not to use abrasive sponges, corrosive detergents, limescale removers, bleach (if in solution > 10%), ammonia (if in solution > 10%), vinegar, abrasive pastes

The quick removal of stains guarantees a better maintenance of the products.
